COLORADO GOLDEN GLOVES STATE TOURNAMENT
FACT SHEET

ATHLETES:

- MUST be registered “online” with **USAB on or before March 13, 2016** (7-days prior to the initial weigh-ins), whether you are a “new” registration OR a “renewal”.
- You **MUST** “**PRE-REGISTER**” or pay a \$10.00 late fee (walk-ins will pay the late fee). Fill out the attached “entry form” and submit to Jeanne DePriest by: email (jhd4boxing@msn.com); or mail (6894 Algonquin Drive, Johnstown, CO 80534), or fax (970-663-1315), or hand deliver on or before March 13th. Individuals that “pre-register” will go to the “initial weigh-ins” on March 20th and check-in with their “**PASSBOOK**” (must include 2016 Membership Card; current photo; proof of citizenship; braces form (if applicable). **NO PASSBOOK, NO WEIGH-IN, NO ENTRY IN DRAW, NO BOX!!!!!!.....**
NO EXCEPTIONS!!!!!!!!!!!!!!. Athletes will receive their Tournament passes at the initial weigh-ins.
- There **WILL NOT** be an “Elite Boxer Division”. (If you are currently an “Elite” Boxer, you will enter the “Open” Division, and you will be wearing “headgear”.)
- **Non-Citizens:** Male/Female athletes may participate in all divisions **EXCEPT** the **OPEN Division**.
- **Open Division (Citizen):** Male/Female athletes must be 17-34 years old and a US Citizen. You **MUST** have a minimum of five (5) bouts - unopposed bouts will not be counted. Male Boxers will box 3, 3 minute rounds AND Female Boxers will box 4, 2 minute rounds.
- **Open Division (Age 35-40):** Male/Female athletes will be matched for **SHOW BOUTS ONLY**. Male/Female athletes must be 35-40 years old and have a “white passbook”. You **MUST** have a minimum of five (5) bouts - unopposed bouts will not be counted. Male Boxers will box 3, 3 minute rounds AND Female Boxers will box 4, 2 minute rounds.
- **Open Division (Non-Citizen):** Male/Female athletes will be matched for **SHOW BOUTS ONLY**. Male/Female athletes must be 17-40 years old (35-40 year old Boxers must have a “white” passbook). You **MUST** have a minimum of five (5) bouts - unopposed bouts will not be counted. Male Boxers will box 3, 3 minute rounds AND Female Boxers will box 4, 2 minute rounds.
- **Novice Divison:** Male/Female athletes must be 17-40 years old (35-40 year old Boxers must have a “white” passbook). You **MUST** have ten (10) or less bouts - unopposed bouts will not be counted. Male Boxers will box 3, 3 minute rounds AND Female Boxers will box 4, 2 minute rounds.

- **Junior Divison:** Male/Female athletes must be 8-16 years old. There is no bout minimum. Male/Female Boxers, Age 8-12 = 3, 1 minute rounds; Age 13-14 = 3, 1-1/2 minute rounds; Age 15-16 = 3, 2 minute rounds.
- **Master Division:** Male/Female athletes must be age 35 and over and have a “yellow” passbook. Male/Female Boxers in the Master Division will box 3, 1 minute rounds.

NON-ATHLETES:

- MUST be “**BOTH**” USAB, REGISTERED (with current Member ID) AND CERTIFIED (with current clinic CCN# or OCN#) in respective passbook in order to work their boxer’s corner AND/OR to work as an Official at ringside. Passbooks **WILL BE** checked for verification in order to obtain a Tournament pass. Non-Athletes will receive their Tournament passes at the initial weigh-ins.

INITIAL WEIGH-INS: (MANDATORY for all boxers entering this Tournament)

- **ALL** athletes **MUST** weigh-in on SUNDAY, March 20, 2016 in order to be included in the “draw” for the Tournament. Weigh-ins will be conducted from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Colorado Golden Gloves Gym, 6161 West 44th Avenue in Wheat Ridge, CO.
- Athletes **MUST** be clean shaven **BEFORE** stepping on scale (no mustaches, beards, goatees, etc., and side burns cannot be below the ear).
- Athletes **WILL BE** allowed to change their weight division “up or down” after stepping on the scale. If an athlete needs to “make weight”, they will have until 2:00 pm to do so. **After 2:00 pm ALL WEIGHTS ARE “FINAL”----NO EXCEPTIONS!!!**
- There will be a “trial scale” set up at the initial weigh-ins from 9:30 am until 1:45 pm. For the “daily weigh-ins”, the trial scale will be available starting at 7:00 am.

DRAW:

- The draw will take place in the CGG Gym at approximately 7:00 pm on Sunday, March 20th.
- The “brackets” and the “bout sheets” will be posted at the following locations: CGG Facebook Page; coloradogoldengloves.com website; and, on the CGG Gym front doors.
- If you need additional information regarding the brackets/bout sheets, please call **AFTER** 8:00 pm on Sunday. Please call Jeanne DePriest at 970-978-5188.

DAILY WEIGH-INS:

- Athletes will **ONLY** weigh-in on the day that they are scheduled to box. (**NOTE:** There will be **NO** weigh-ins on **Monday, March 21st**. **Those that are boxing on Monday already weighed-in on Sunday**).
- Daily weigh-ins will be from 8:00 am to 9:00 am each morning at the CGG Gym, location stated above. **At 9:00 am, all Athletes who have not arrived to weigh-in WILL BE disqualified.**
- **SPECIAL NOTE:** If any athlete needs to weigh-in at an earlier time due to their school schedule, we will be happy to accommodate you. Please contact E. Paul Kelly, Jr. at 720-422-3025 or Jeanne DePriest at 970-978-5188 to make the necessary arrangements.
- At the daily weigh-ins, you will have until 9:00 am to make weight.
- At the “daily weigh-ins”, Please note: For Example...If you are in the 132 lb weight division, you can weigh a maximum of 132 lbs, but there is no “minimum” weight required.

COMPETITION:

Dates: March 21, 2016 through March 26, 2016

Site: Colorado Golden Gloves Gym at 6161 W 44th Avenue in Wheat Ridge, CO

Bout Times: Mon., Tues., Wed., Thu., Fri. = 7:00 pm. and Sat., 7:30 pm. (Doors open one hour prior to bout time)

Tickets: \$20.00/Ringside and \$15.00/General Admission

Age: All Male and Female Athletes, ages 8 and up.

Age determination date for All Division Boxers is **”your age in Calendar Year 2016”** (Example: If you are 14 today and you will turn 15 on December 31, 2016, then you are 15 for this Tournament.)

Lodging: All teams are responsible for their own lodging.

Equipment: Gloves **WILL BE** provided and **ALL** boxers will be gloved and their handwraps checked at the glove table. Tape and gauze **WILL NOT** be provided. Headgear will **ONLY** be provided for the Master Boxers Division. **ALL** Boxers in this Tournament **WILL** wear headgear. The headgear **MUST BE** USAB/AIBA approved with **NO** cheek protectors. Mouthpieces cannot **NOT** have any “variation of red”. It is **NOT** mandatory that you wear red/blue headgear **OR** red/blue uniforms, but it is strongly encouraged. PLEASE NOTE.....regarding the uniforms....no nicknames, no fringe, no sequins, and the length of the trunks **MUST NOT** go beyond the knees. There **MUST BE** a “contrasting waistband” between the jerseys and the trunks. These rules **WILL BE** enforced.

Designated Prep Area: There will be an area at the venue designated specifically for Coaches & Athletes to prep their boxers prior to their bouts.

AWARDS: (Distributed ONLY to those Athletes that “box”, unless otherwise notated)

Pee Wee (8 & 9-10) & Bantam (11-12) (Male/Female) Champion: Trophy & T-Shirt
Pee Wee (8 & 9-10) & Bantam (11-12) (Male/Female) Runner-up: Trophy & T-Shirt
(Unopposed Champions will receive a t-shirt & medal unless they are matched for a Show Bout)

Intermediate (13-14) & Junior (15-16) (Male/Female) Champion: Trophy & T-Shirt
Intermediate (13-14) & Junior (15-16) (Male/Female) Runner-up: Trophy & T-Shirt
(Unopposed Champions will receive a t-shirt & medal unless they are matched for a Show Bout)

Senior Novice (17-40) (Male/Female) – Champion: Jacket & T-Shirt
Senior Novice (17-40) (Male/Female) – Runner-up: Hooded Sweat-Shirt & T-Shirt
(Unopposed Champions will receive a t-shirt & medal unless they are matched for a Show Bout)

Senior Open (Citizen) (17-34) (Male/Female) – Champion: Jacket, Belt, T-Shirt
Senior Open (Citizen) (17-34) (Male/Female) – Runner-up: Hooded Sweat-Shirt & T-Shirt
(Unopposed “Male” Champions will receive the same awards as Senior Open (Citizen)
(Unopposed “Female” Champions will receive a t-shirt & medal unless they are matched for a Show Bout)

Master (yellow)-(35 & over) (Male/Female) - Champion: Jacket & T-Shirt
Master (yellow)-(35 & over) (Male/Female) - Runner-up: Hooded Sweat-Shirt & T-Shirt
(Unopposed Champions will receive a t-shirt & medal unless they are matched for a Show Bout)

SHOW BOUTS (“Unopposed Boxers”; “Open, Non-Citizens”; and “Open, 35-40 white passbook” WILL BE MATCHED FOR SHOW BOUTS, if at all possible.)
Champion: Trophy & T-Shirt & Runner-up: Trophy & T-Shirt

SPECIAL AWARDS will be distributed to the following:

- Outstanding Bout per night awarded to both boxers
- Team Trophy

SCHOLARSHIPS

For 2016, there will be four (4), \$500.00 scholarships awarded to Boxers in honor of:

REGIONAL AND NATIONAL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- Male and Female (if applicable), Colorado Open Class Champions (US Citizens Only) will compete in the Regional Golden Gloves Tournament in Albuquerque, NM on Saturday, April 23, 2016. *Note: All Male, Open Class Champions will receive a uniform for the Regional GG Tournament. All Female, Open Class Champions will receive a uniform, ONLY if they are participating in the National Female GG Tournament in July 2016.
- “Male” Champions of the Regional Tournament will advance to the National Golden Gloves Tournament in Salt Lake City, UT - May 16-21, 2016.
- The “Female” National Golden Gloves Tournament will be held in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida – July 4-9, 2016. (This is an open tournament for Female Boxers)
